

Key Vocabulary/Concepts

Parable- a story used to teach a lesson or a moral

Agape- Christian love (selfless)

Incarnation- God in human form (God the son; Jesus)

Judgement Day- a belief that people will be judged by God on their actions. If they are good people they will be rewarded with entry to heaven.

Golden Rule- a key teaching of Jesus to treat people how you want to be treated

Forgiveness- the action or process of forgiving or being forgiven

Forgiveness- the action or process of forgiving or being forgiven

Reconciliation- a situation in which two people or groups of people become make up again after they have fallen out

How does Jesus Inspire?

The Trinity is a Christian belief that there is one God in three persons; God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. This is revealed in the Bible and taught through the Church. The Creed (prayer of belief) is an important statement of belief about the Trinity.

The Lord's Prayer was taught by Jesus to his followers as way to communicate with God the Father. The prayer reveals God is omnipotent (all-powerful) and forgiving; *"forgive us"*.

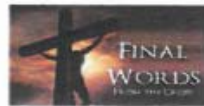
Martin Luther King was a black Baptist minister who wanted to end the oppression (unfair treatment) of black people in the USA in the 1950s and 60s. He felt the time had come to take a stand against the racial injustice he saw all around him. He was inspired by **Jesus'** teachings to seek peace, equality and justice.



Anthony Walker was murdered in 2005 because of his race. His mother Gee, forgave her son's killers because she was a Christian. She followed **Jesus** command to *"forgive, not 7 times but 77 times."*

"Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Jesus said this while suffering on the cross

"But I say to you, do not resist an evil person; but whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also." **Jesus taught people to not retaliate.**



"But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." **Jesus promoted peace.**

♥ **The Good Samaritan**

"Love your neighbour"

This teaches people to love their neighbour, to act selflessly. Christians are expected to follow Jesus' example to put agape (selfless love) into action.



The Lost Son

"he was lost and is found"

Also known as Prodigal Son, this parable reveals God is benevolent (loving)& forgiving.



The Sheep & Goats



"Whenever you refused to help these least important ones, you refused to help me'."

This teaches people to care for all people as though they are Jesus.
